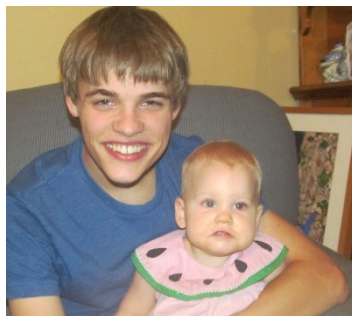
Ariela, 13 mos.

The team in Hungary has finished the Gospel of Mark in Bayash Roma and is working on a series of discipleship Bible studies entitled "Walking with Jesus". They're editing the draft trans-

Interestingly, the younger Roma are gaining more Internet access so the team has started a Facebook page in Bayash Roma and hope to develop online interactive Bible studies in Bayash which can be accessed by Internet.

I am working to finish my PhD in New Testament Greek and Linguistics so that I will be qualified to serve as a Bible translation consultant for the Roma (Gypsy) dialects of Hungary, Croatia and Serbia. I recently traveled to

For moving to Budapest, setting up and learning the languages, we need one-time gifts to cover the following:

- Airfare from Kansas City to Budapest: \$5,700
- Shipping belongings to Budapest: \$5,500
- 1st year visas: \$1,630
- Deposit on house rental: \$2,200
- Furniture, appliances, household goods, office equipment: \$9,700
- Purchase of vehicle: \$7,700
- 2 years of language classes, tutors, books, CDs: \$15,000
- If each person, church, or small group gave a \$100 one-time gift, we would have what we need for our move, set up & language learning.
